







DONATION OF FACE MASKS TO VIETNAM

In June, Club member Danny Low approached the club indicating that he had identified a source of surplus face masks for which there was great demand in Vietnam where despite initial strong efforts at controlling the pandemic there were rapidly increasing COVID case numbers. The Board agreed to support the administration of arranging supply from the Medical Repurposing Network (a project of the Rotary Club of Sydney Cove) and also supporting logistics and freight cost from warehouse to Vietnam of a 20 foot container with 300,000+ KN95 face masks. The shipment has arrived and was distributed to two different provinces and as you can see was very well received by our colleagues in Vietnam. Danny is also keeping in touch with the starting up of Rotary in Vietnam which given our Club's long involvement in medical training in that country should augur well for identification of future potential projects.
