Windsor and Parramatta and attacking Sydney from the inland thereby avoiding the harbour defenses. Due to the Napoleonic Wars this plan never saw the light of day.

.As most of our readers would be aware, our Club has been a long-time supporter of Women & Children First and attached as a reminder is a write-up of their activities and an invitation to a fund-raising event to be held on 4th March.

WOMEN & CHILDREN

Women & Children First

It takes a village to raise a family! We are their village.

Women & Children First is a not-for-profit, community-based service for women and vulnerable families, including women and children escaping domestic and family violence.

Our vision is to ensure women, children and families are safe, secure, connected and provided with the opportunity and environment to thrive.

We have two **Women and Children's Refuges** on the North Shore and Northern Beaches that provide crisis accommodation to women and children escaping domestic violence. Crisis accommodation is for up to three months and we provide case management to address the complex needs of mothers and their children at this time. We also have transitional housing to assist women and children once they are out of the crisis situation.

We assist women and their children to find ongoing safe, affordable housing so they may live their lives independently now and into the future.

Our **Northern Beaches Family Support Services** supports vulnerable families with children aged 0 to 12 years with specialist programs:

- Parenting skills group work, in particular, Circle of Security, Emotion Coaching, Tuning into Kids, Cool Tools, Drop-in and Share, and Messy Play.
- Parenting support through individual casework, information, advice and referrals.
- Supported playgroup (provided by <u>Integricare</u>)
- Case management
- Home visiting
